

### Legacy Community Foundation Progress...

The Legacy Committee has approved the third design concept envisioning the “Anchors of the Community” memorial. The proposed location for the attractive, circular design is just north of the existing Gateway Lighthouse and close to the edge of the bay so that bay water can be used to efficiently provide the water fountain feature.

The latest design affords minimal maintenance and should lower the cost to approximately \$17,000. Construction contributions from residents and area businesses are being sought at this time and it is hoped that future bequests will provide contributions to our community foundation so that funds are available as “seed money” to garner larger grants to improve our community. As always, your thoughts are both invited and most welcome.

### Harborlands Study Progress...

The Harborlands Steering Committee approved a more ecologically designed habitat restoration unit to include a robust “fish hatching nursery”. The new iteration will withstand winter ice flows and is designed to replicate a natural island. The structure will meet the Port Authority’s need for a dredged material confinement facility and could eliminate the controversial open lake disposal of dredged material.

The rebuilt island structure will also mitigate a hazard to navigation while providing a destination for boaters, fishermen, hunters, birders and tourists.
