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RULES & INFORMATION

These rules are designed for the orderly control and safety of all involved; to ensure the success of the Parade with the specific goal of providing safe and wholesome entertainment for our community. The Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse participation to any person or group for unsafe or inappropriate behavior.

Parade Participant Parking – Parade Participants' vehicles may be parked at Edgewater School, 5549 131st or at Cullen Park.

Line-Up Number Sign – A parade official will hang your entry number from the passenger side mirror. This is EXTREMELY important so the Announcer and Judges can correctly identify your unit as you pass in review.

Parade Route – The Parade will officially begin at Summit and 108th Streets, proceed straight up Summit, turn right on 131st and end at Friendship Park Community Center. **It is very important that you complete the entire Parade route to the end.**

Spacing & Gaps – Distance between units should be approximately 30' to 50'. Please pay attention and if a larger gap develops, please re-establish the proper distance.

Decorations – Stars, Stripes, and Shoreline. Your unit should be decorated in some way to reflect the theme! Float ideas: From Sea to Shining Sea, Salute to our shoreline heroes, Fireworks on the waterfront, Lighthouse of Liberty etc.

Emergency Units – All Police, Fire, and EMS units will be near the front of the Parade in case an emergency departure is required. In case of emergency, all units are required to give way for all emergency vehicles.

Dignitaries – All dignitaries must personally appear in or near the entry bearing their name.

Animals – All animals must have a designated person responsible for immediately collecting animal droppings. Please remember the Parade route can be a very long walk for animals, especially if it's hot. **All pets must always have immediate access to fresh water before, during, and after the Parade.**

Weather – The Parade will go on rain or shine and will only be suspended in case of lightning. Please dress appropriately, use sunscreen and stay hydrated.

Award Categories – You have picked which one you want to be judged under on your application. (1st, 2nd and 3rd place):

- Best Overall Application of the Parade Theme
- Most Patriotic
- Best Marching Unit

Giveaways & Safety – Parade spectators love giveaways, but they **MUST BE DISTRIBUTED BY WALKING PARTICIPANTS ONLY. NO THROWING CANDY!! IT MUST BE HANDED OUT!!** No Firearms are permitted to be fired and no open flames are allowed. Water/Squirt guns, super soakers, hoses, silly string, or any other item potentially dangerous to spectators of participants are prohibited. **NOTHING MAY BE THROWN OR SPRAYED BY ANY ENTRY.** The Parade Committee is not responsible for any accident. Alcohol and drugs are **PROHIBITED** from all floats, vehicles, and Parade participants.

Litter Control – With a little cooperation and help from everyone, our volunteers will have less work to do after the Parade.
